Officer-in-Charge, Historic Ship NAUTILUS (SSN 571)
Director, Submarine Force Museum



Lieutenant Commander Derek Sutton is a native of Upstate New York. He enlisted in 2002 to be a nuclear-trained Machinist's Mate. He received his acceptance to the United States Naval Academy and was commissioned in May of 2007. Completing his initial training at Naval Nuclear Power Training Command, Naval Nuclear Power Training Unit (Charleston), and the Submarine Officer Basic Course, he reported to Bangor, WA for his Division Officer tour onboard the USS LOUISIANA (GOLD) in late 2008.

As a member of USS LOUISIANA, LCDR Sutton served as the Electrical Assistant, Reactor Control Assistant, Communications Officer, Damage Control Assistant, and Assistant to the Engineer Officer. He completed 4 strategic deterrent patrols and requested orders to be a Shift Engineer.

LCDR served as a Shift Engineer at the Nuclear Power Training Unit (Charleston) from early 2012 to early 2015.

After his Shift Engineer tour, LCDR Sutton completed the Submarine Officer Advanced Course at Submarine Base, New London before reporting to USS FLORIDA (GOLD) in King's Bay, GA as the Engineer Officer in September of 2015.

LCDR Sutton completed one deployment and an extended availability as the Engineer Officer and then reported to Norfolk, VA as the Submarine Squadron SIX Engineer Officer in 2018. LCDR Sutton relieved as the Officer-in-Charge of Historic Ship NAUTILUS and Director of U.S. Submarine Force Museum in 2021.

LCDR Sutton's awards and decorations include a Navy Unit Commendation Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (Gold Star in lieu of 3rd Award), the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (Gold Star in lieu of 2nd Award), and other campaign and service awards

The Nautilus Alumni Association's scholarship program (aka Nautilus Education Assistance Fund administered by the Dolphin Scholarship Foundation) is accepting applications on the website **dolphinscholarship.org** for Fall 2022 college admission.

High school seniors and undergraduate college students who are either the child, grandchild, great-grandchild (whether by marriage or adoption) or the spouse of a Nautilus Alumni member who served honorably for at least 30 days on the Historic Ship Nautilus are eligible. The process begins when the student registers. The Dolphin administrator takes a day or two to confirm that that student's sponsor is valid, after which the student will receive information on how to proceed fulfilling application requirements.

We members can boast that for the Fall 2021 scholastic year, two students, Ryan Tinder, sponsored by Clarence Allen, 1958-1961, EN2/MM1 and Logan Garwood, sponsored by his grandfather Dean Garwood, 1964, EM3, each received a \$3400 award. It is hoped that the awards can remain at that level (or better) for Fall 2022.

Online application and attendant documentation must be <u>received</u> by the Dolphin Scholarship administrator by March 15, 2022. Awards are announced late April or May.
