New Year Greetings from the Scholarship Corner: March 15 is the deadline for applications to have been received by the Dolphin Scholarship administrator to be considered for the Spring 2022 scholarship sward. Repeat: all materials and information must have been received by March 15 – not post marked.

To NAAI members: please advise your student applicants that it is necessary for <u>them</u> to apply online. There is no form to fill out. The website is <u>dolphinscholarship.org</u>. Click on Scholarships tile. Click on How to Apply, Click on Nautilus Scholarship. Click again on "Apply."

The applicant begins the process by providing basic contact information and the identity of their sponsor and submits this information to the Dolphin administrator who then requests from me a confirmation that the sponsor is legitimate. If so, the Dolphin administrator responds to the applicant with instructions about how to proceed towards completion of the nitty-gritty application.

We currently have eight students in various stages of their application; two of them are past scholarship winners.

Over the years, the Board of Directors has found numerous ways to raise money to support projects worthy of our mission. The primary method to recognize membership prior to the Pandemic was the Lifetime Crew Membership (\$100), Annual Crew Membership (\$10), and Lifetime Legacy Membership (\$25). During the Pandemic, it became increasingly difficult to have a reunion and the collection of dues. The Board felt that paying to be a member of the NAAI for an individual that served on the USS Nautilus SSN-571 was counter-productive to having an effective organization that represented all that served. So the Board eliminated the annual membership for Crew of the Nautilus.

Since there have been safety issues and we could not confirm facilities for the Bi-annual Reunion due to COVID closures, the NAAI was not spending monies and therefore managed through the Pandemic with little to no impact on the fund balance averaging around \$5,500. In 2021 the Board started planning the 2022 Reunion and several projects to improve membership communication and enhance the NEAF Scholarship Program. The Board felt strongly about NAAI Membership being free to Crew, so we identified a way to build out fund balance through voluntary donations.

In 2018 the Bostic Watch Company was looking for the organization that represented the USS Nautilus and a Membership Association. They planned to create a series of watches highlighting the USS Nautilus and her Crew – thus identifying the NAAI as that focal point. After reviewing designs, an agreement was completed whereby a percentage of watches would be donated to the NAAI over the sales cycle of that watch series. In 2021 we received 36 watches with an average wholesale price of about \$500 each.We plan to establish fundraising events whereby a \$10 or more donation will be entered into a drawing to receive a watch. Our first drawing event will be held at the Reunion Banquet in July (you do not have to be present to win). We plan to give away five (5) watches to all who donate \$10 or more (one opportunity no matter how much per member) until check-in is complete at the Reunion in Groton. As we continue in the future, communication will go out for drawing to recognize historical dates related to the USS Nautilus. Information on the uses of these funds will also be shared that enhances the overall value of NAAI membership.
